

## TriArt Festival

# Artisan Agreement

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1. A copy of vendor's valid **California Resale Certificate** must be submitted with the Application. The vendor is responsible for reporting any and all taxes to the *State Board of Equalization*.
2. There will be no sharing of booth space. Only one artisan is to be named on the Agreement and that artisan will be the only one allowed to operate in that given booth space. All artisans are to remain open the entire time from 1pm-9pm.
3. Booth space is in the form of a 10'x10' canopy. We will supply 2 chairs and a table. If you need additional space for your display racks or table, it must be requested in advance.
4. Artists must use the festival canopies, but may bring their own easels, racks and chairs.
5. The space around the artisan's booths must be kept accessible to guests and emergency vehicles. No tables, display racks or any other display of art work shall protrude further than 12" from any booth pole.
6. Any violation of the above mentioned items or unwillingness to cooperate with Festival staff regarding complaints or violations will be cause for removal from the festival and all monies forfeited.
7. Set-up can begin Saturday at 10:00am. All delivery vehicles must be off grounds by 11:30am. Set up must be completed by 12:00pm. On Sunday, tear-down cannot begin until after the event closing time.
8. No merchandise can be left over night. The TriArt Committee, staff or volunteers or the event sponsors are not responsible for any items left on the venue grounds by vendors during the event or after hours.
